



The Immigration Service application form guide

This guide is meant as an aid if you wish to apply for a visa (short stay), a Danish residence permit or an extension of an existing permit. You should be able to find the form which best matches your situation. The guide is in two parts:

- Refer to form guide 1 if you are first time applicant for a Danish residence permit
- Refer to form guide 2 if you have a Danish CPR number and need to apply for an extension of your existing permit.

Apply for a Danish residence permit, because your spouse/partner is to work or study in Denmark	FA8: Application for residence and work permit for family members of a foreign national who is to work or study in Denmark. Please note that children staying with a parent who is to work or study in Denmark also can use this form to apply for a residence permit.
Bring someone to Denmark	If you wish to bring someone to Denmark you need to be aware that he / she is the applicant for permission to reside in Denmark. Use the relevant application forms which best matches his / her situation.
