



The Immigration Service Application Form Guide

15 April 2016

This guide can help you, if you wish to submit an application to the Danish Immigration Service. Use this guide if your application concerns visa (short stay), family reunification, work as religious worker, temporary extension or permanent residence.

The guide can help you find the form which best matches your situation. The guide is divided into four groups:

- Form guide 1: If you wish to apply for a visa (short term).
- Form guide 2: If you are first time applicant for a Danish residence permit.
- Form guide 3: If you wish to apply for an extension of your existing residence permit.
- Form guide 4: If you wish to apply for a permanent residence permit.

Please note: it is mandatory to use digital (online) self-service for certain types of applications. For other types of applications it is mandatory to use printable application forms. Unless you are exempt from this requirement. Mandatory online solutions and forms are marked with a red star (*) in the guide.

Religious work as a member of the clergy, missionary, nun or monk	RF1: Application for residence permit for religious workers
Foreign national child born in Denmark	BO1: Application for residence permit for a child born in Denmark
Apply for a Danish residence permit for accompanying family member of a religious worker	RF2: Application for residence permit for accompanying family member of a religious worker
Bring someone to Denmark	If you wish to bring someone to Denmark you need to be aware that he / she is the applicant for permission to reside in Denmark. Use the relevant application forms which best matches his / her situation.
