



SIRI Application form guide

July 2017

This guide is meant as an aid if you wish to apply for:

- **A residence permit based on work, studies, the Greencard scheme, Establishment card, the Start-up Denmark scheme, as an au pair, intern or volunteer or to qualify for an authorization as a doctor or dentist**
- **A residence permit as an accompanying family member**
- **An extension of a residence permit based on one of the schemes above**
- **A permanent residence permit**
- **A re-entry permit or a residence card**

The guide helps you to find the form which best matches your situation. The guide is in two parts:

- **Refer to form guide 1 if you are first time applicant for a Danish residence permit**
- **Refer to form guide 2 if you need to apply for an extension of your existing permit**
- **Refer to form guide 3 if you need to apply for something else**
